Day	Events
Thursday 9/17	1000 to 1730. Check-in to Reunion after checking into the Fox Tower Hotel. Reunion check-in table located in lobby of the hotel. Receive name tags, reunion swag, and important information. 1800 to 2100. Welcome to the Reunion at our Mix n’ Mingle Event. Held at the USSVI Groton Base Clubhouse, 40 School Street Groton, CT 06340. Transportation via your own vehicles, rideshare with other attendees, or via the 8-passenger shuttle that will run continuously between Foxwoods and the Clubhouse during the event. Light buffet dinner and beverages provided.
Friday 9/18	0600 to 0800. Full breakfast buffet. Breakfast buffet set out in the Monterey room with seating available in the Aspen Room next door on the 10th floor of The Grand Pequot Tower. Allow time to travel to and from the Grand Pequot Tower and The Fox Tower Hotel on the Foxwoods campus to ensure you get back in time to catch the bus tour! All Foxwoods hotels are connected by indoor walkways. 0800 to 0815. Board either of two buses in front of The Fox Tower Hotel for the Back to SUBASE event. Must depart by 0830. 0900 to 1400. Back to SUBASE event. Everyone 18 and older must bring the same identification you provided when registering with us for base access. Our two buses bring you first to the Submarine Force Library and Museum outside the SUBASE Main Gate. There will be an opportunity here to walk through the Museum while the buses receive a security sweep. We will then reboard the buses at 1000 for an ID check prior to driving on base. Each bus will have a tour guide provided by SUBASE PAO. At 1045, after touring the base, there will be a Welcome by SUBASE PAO Staff and SUBFOR 101 Brief at the Dealey Theater. From 1200 to 1230, there will be a Dealey Plaza Walking Tour (if time allows). Finally, from 1230 to 1400, a pizza luncheon provided at the on-base Reunions Pub where we will be joined by some Submarine School students for a unique socialization opportunity. We board buses from there for the trip back to The Fox Tower Hotel. 1500. Transportation via your own vehicles, rideshare with other attendees, or via the 8-passenger shuttle that will make a single trip to and from the event. We will be gathering on the after deck of Historic Ship Nautilus and vicinity promptly at 1000 with a service Chaplain to remember and honor departed members of our deep submergence community. Following this remembrance, you're encouraged to tour Nautilus and visit any parts of the Museum you may have missed the day before. The remainder of the morning and afternoon is free time for all to enjoy the Foxwoods campus and the local Groton/New London area. 1800 to 2100. Reunion Banquet. Located in the Vue room on the 10th floor of The Grand Pequot Tower. Cash bar available throughout the event. 1800-1900 Reception and Deep Submergence Group welcome. 1900-2100 formal banquet dinner buffet. During dinner, there will be presentations about NR-1 and by our two keynote speakers, Dick Taylor and Marty Klein. This is the final reunion event. Valet parking available in Grand Pequot Tower + The Fox Tower

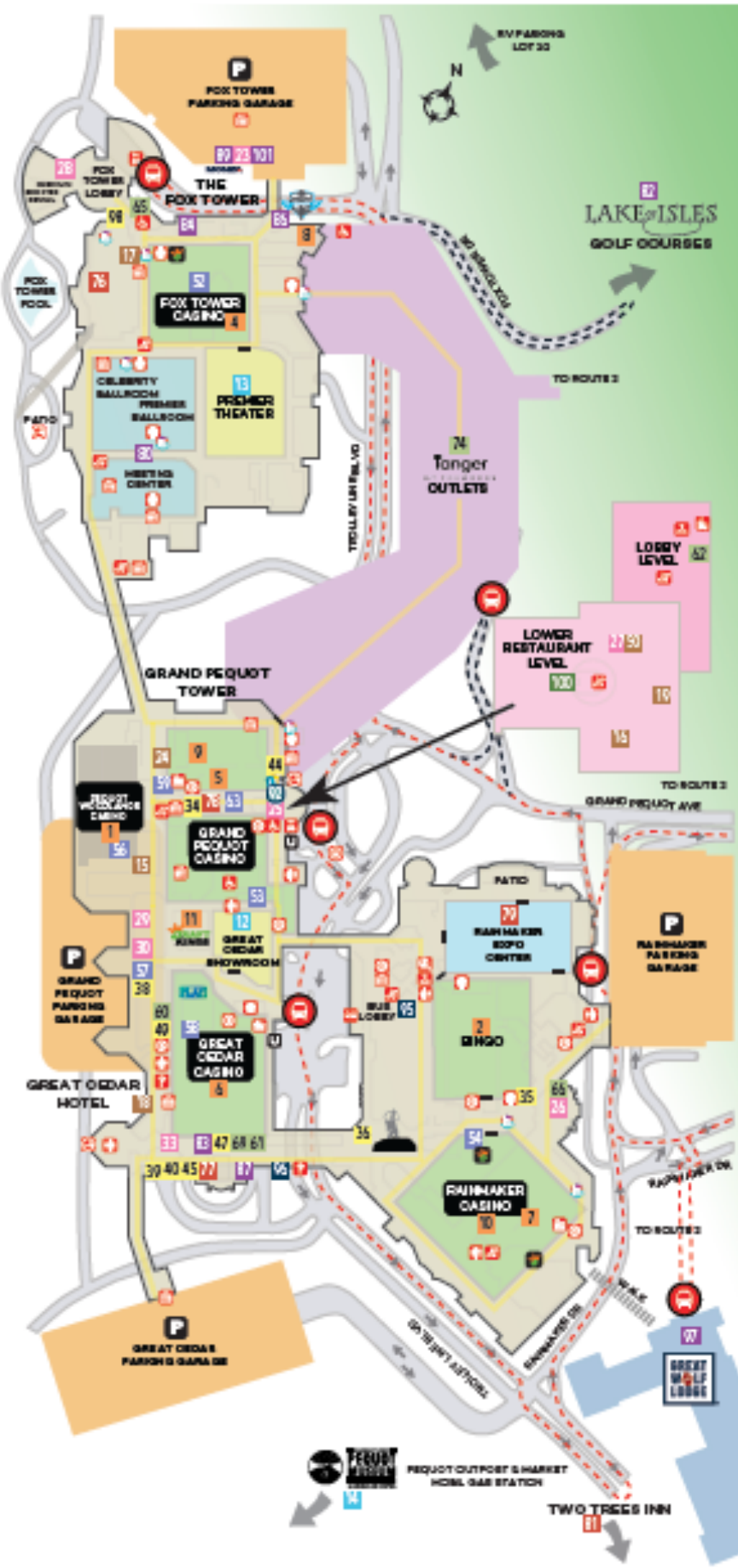
NEW ENCLOSED HANDICAP PARKING NOW AVAILABLE IN RAINMAKER GARAGE
